### **Water Tower Lights**

On a motion by Councilmember Elmore, seconded by Councilmember Rainbolt to allow Larned Alumni Association to obtain estimates for lights for the Larned Water Tower.

Rick Yeager, representative of the Larned Alumni association approached the Council to request permission to raise funds to purchase new light for the water tower. The Alumni stated they would be working with Golden Belt Community Foundation.

### **Country Living Request**

Item was tabled until next meeting so representatives from Country Living could be present.

### **Utility HelpNet**

Representative from Utility HelpNet was not present. Discussion took place and was decided, City Manager Massey would make contact with the representative. It was also agreed that City Attorney Smith would draw up a letter with a Damage Clause. Discussion would take place at the next meeting.


### **Chamber of Commerce - Santa Fe Trail Days**
