Venture Corporation Contract

The water line break at the intersection of 10th Street and Broadway caused major damage on a State highway. The repair of the intersection will include closing one lane of traffic; the project is only expected to take two days and is estimated to be completed by the first part of March. The eastside of Broadway and 10th street was also damaged and City crews will do the repair work.

Allen also received a bid to repair the alley behind the Post Office. He suggests asphalt because of the high usage, Venture could do this in an afternoon while they repair 10th and Broadway.

Total cost for 10th and Broadway is \$44,100, the alley overlay is \$16,800, this would come from Special Highway Funds.

Councilmember Murray motioned to accept the bid, Councilmember McGinness seconded. Council would like the contract to state that the project needs to be completed by the end of March or it is void.


Motion passed.
