

City Council Meeting Minutes

Appropriation Ordinance #2

Finance Director Monica Steiner reported on the expenses listed on the financial report. On a motion by Councilmember Rainbolt and seconded by Councilmember Clark and carried for Appropriation Ordinance #2 in the amount of \$632,817.83 and transfers more or less were approved for payment.

New Business

KDOT CCLIP Application

KDOT is now accepting applications for FY 2025. The application is for a surface preservation project on Broadway between 8th St. and the general mid-point between 12th and 13th Streets.

A surface preservation project consists of milling the road and overlaying it or patching it. KDOT will pay 95% of the construction and construction engineering costs, while


preliminary engineering costs are not included in the match. These projects have a maximum KDOT match of \$400,000.

Allen Taylor, Superintendent of the Street Department, let the council know that in the scope of this project there are 18 ADA ramps along Broadway that would need replaced to comply with current regulations. If the contractor were to replace them the cost would be \$50,000, that would come off the \$400,000 allotted for the project. Allen said his crew would do the replacement of each of the 18 ramps that would be replaced.

Councilmember Barnes motioned to approve the application for FY 2025 KDOT CCLIP Application. Councilmember Molleker seconded.

Motion passed.
